- 1. Site work, grading, gravel, and cleanup complete
- 2. 2-year inspection scheduled for early 2020

 - a. Water lines to be eight-inch and four-inch HDPE
 - b. Kellogg Engineering is the project engineer working for Developer
 - c. Water line installation 100% complete
 - d. Anticipate Final Acceptance of Project in February
- 2. Presley Hollow Owasso Area 198 Lots
 - a. Water lines to be twelve-inch, eight-inch, and six-inch C-900 PVC
 - b. ODEQ construction permit for pending
 - c. Water line installation anticipated starting in February
